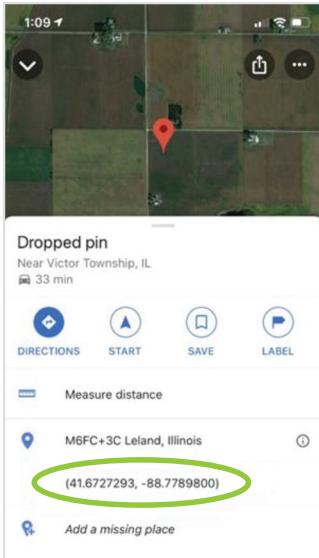


Pin Drop Delivery

Now Available

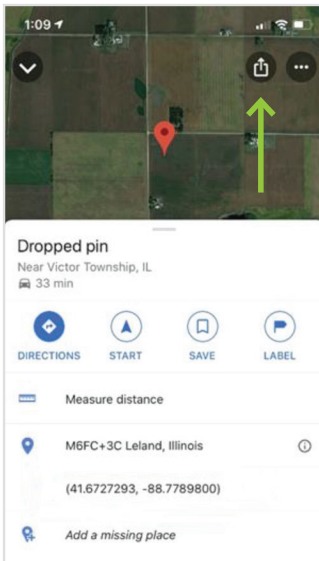
Ensure pipe is delivered exactly where you want it with ADS Pin Drop capability.

Always use Google Maps to ensure matching latitude and longitude numbers for our system. See page two for cellular app download instructions, if needed.



1. **Open Google Maps** on your computer, tablet or cell phone.
2. **Choose a location** for the pipe to be delivered.
3. **Hold down** on the screen to create a dropped pin.
4. Once it is created, **click** on the description (or **swipe up** from an iPhone) to expand.

This will show the decimal portion that is needed.



5. **Click on the Share** button in top right corner of screen.
6. Options to **share via text message or email** will appear.
7. **Share pin** through text message to your sales rep or email to Customer Service Representative
8. If you're able to **send directly to P.O. Fax/CSR**, that is the preference. Otherwise, sales will email to P.O. Fax/CSR on your behalf.
9. CSR will **add pin drop coordinates into the order acknowledgement** and send to the dispatcher.
10. Dispatcher will upload coordinates into driver's software program for **accurate delivery** location.



Don't have Google Maps on your iPhone or Android

See below for download instructions.

iPhone - Google Maps download:

- Unlock your iPhone using your passcode, Touch ID, or Face ID.
- Open the App Store app.
- Search Google Maps using the Search tab.
- Tap 'Get' to the right of the app.
- Confirm installation by entering your passcode or using Touch ID. If you have an iPhone X, double-click the side button to activate Face ID and confirm the installation.
- The app will install on your iPhone (small status circle to the right of the app in the App Store).
- Once the app has finished installing, it will show up on the Home screen of your iPhone.
- You may have to scroll (by swiping right to left on your iPhone's display) to your second or third Home screen to find the app.

Android - Google Maps download:

- Tap the Apps icon. Located at the bottom of the home screen. The app looks like several dots/small squares inside of a circle.
- Scroll down and tap Play Store. Its icon is a multicolored triangle on the white briefcase.
 - If it's your first time opening the Play Store, you'll have to enter your Google account information and payment details. Follow the on-screen instructions when prompted.
- Type Google Maps into the search box. It's at the top of the screen.
- Tap the Search key.
- Select Google Maps from the search results.
- Tap Install. It is a green button just beneath the name of the app.
- Tap Open. The app will open. In the future, it can be found under the Apps icon on home screen.
